

**RESOLUTION NO. -2017, DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT
OF PUBLIC WORKS TO INSTALL A TRAFFIC CONTROL
SIGNAL AT THE INTERSECTION OF CR 101 AND HARRISON
AVENUE**

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 274-2017 amended the 2017 Capital Budget to provide funding for traffic signal improvements at CR 101 and Harrison Avenue in Bellport; and

WHEREAS, in order to commence work on this project, the Legislature must direct the Department of Public Works ("DPW") to install the light at this intersection; and

WHEREAS, DPW should commence work on this project immediately to improve the safety of this busy intersection; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the Department of Public Works is hereby authorized, empowered and directed, pursuant to § C8-2(W) of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CHARTER, to take all steps necessary to install a traffic control signal at the intersection of CR 101 and Harrison Avenue in Bellport; and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20), (21) and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
