**RESOLUTION NO. 96 -2014, TO APPOINT DEBORAH LOHMAN AS A MEMBER OF THE SUFFOLK COUNTY CITIZENS ADVISORY BOARD FOR THE ARTS**

**WHEREAS**, the Citizens Advisory Board for the Arts was created to suggest, review and recommend arts policies and programs for Suffolk County; and

**WHEREAS**, members of the Citizens Advisory Board for the Arts may be recommended by individual County Legislators and are subject to approval by the full Legislature; and

**WHEREAS**, Local Law No. 9-2011 expanded the membership of the Citizens Advisory Board for the Arts to 18 members, one to represent each Legislative district; now, therefore, be it

**1st RESOLVED**, that **Deborah Lohman**, currently residing in Shoreham, New York, is hereby appointed as a member of the Suffolk County Citizens Advisory Board for the Arts to represent Legislative District No. 6, for a term of office to expire three years subsequent to the effective date of this resolution, pursuant to Chapter 103 of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CODE; and be it further

**2nd RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20), (21), and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
