**RESOLUTION NO. 932 -2014, TO REAPPOINT LYN

**1st RESOLVED**, that **Lyn Boland**, currently residing in Setauket, New York, is hereby reappointed as a member of the Suffolk County Citizens Advisory Board for the Arts for a three-year term of office to expire on June 30, 2015, pursuant to Section 103-3(A) of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CODE; and be it further

**2nd RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20), (21), and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
