**RESOLUTION NO. -2016, AMENDING THE 2016 CAPITAL  
BUDGET AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN CONNECTION  
WITH IMPROVEMENTS TO NORTH FORK COUNTY  
PRESERVE (CP 7189)**

**WHEREAS**, the North Fork County Preserve is a major County parkland acquisition; and

**WHEREAS**, the stormwater piping system that was in place when the property was purchased is insufficient to protect the environment from uncontrolled stormwater runoff due to large storm events; and

**WHEREAS**, stormwater runoff generated from the North Fork County Preserve may contain waste from wildlife and other contaminants; and

**WHEREAS**, the most environmentally sustainable and efficacious way to address excess water on the North Fork County Preserve is to recharge the water and prevent discharge into the Long Island Sound, an Estuary of National Significance; and

**WHEREAS**, the Suffolk County Department of Public Works, the Suffolk County Department of Parks, Recreation, and Conservation, and the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation have been consulted and have cooperated in an effort to correct this issue; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined that the Department of Public Works has sufficient resources to restore the wetlands on the property, allowing stormwater to be recharged into the aquifer and eliminating discharge to the Long Island Sound, while also protecting nearby roadways from flooding; and

**WHEREAS**, in cooperation with the Suffolk County Department of Public Works, the Suffolk County Department of Parks, Recreation, and Conservation shall conduct the planning in-house; and

**WHEREAS**, there are sufficient funds within the 2016 Capital Budget and Program, currently allocated to planning, to cover the cost of construction for this project; and

**WHEREAS**, that this Legislature, by resolution of even date herewith, has authorized the issuance of \$200,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 471-1994, as revised by Resolution No. 571-1998, Resolution No. 209-2000 and Resolution No. 461-2006 established the use of a priority ranking system, implemented in the Adopted 2016 Capital Budget, as the basis for funding capital projects such as this project; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup> RESOLVED**, that it is hereby determined that this project, with a priority ranking of forty (40) is eligible for approval in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 471-1994 as revised by Resolution No. 571-1998, Resolution No. 209-2000 and Resolution No. 461-2006; and be it further

**2<sup>nd</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that the 2016 Capital Budget and Program be and they are hereby amended as follows:

**4<sup>th</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that the Suffolk County Department of Public Works and the Suffolk County Department of Parks, Recreation, and Conservation are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to take such actions as may be necessary for improvements to the North Fork County Preserve; and be it further

**5<sup>th</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) Lead Agency, hereby finds and determines that the adoption of this law is a Type II action, pursuant to Title 6 NYCRR Part 617.5(C) (1), (2), (20) and (27), since it constitutes a local legislative decision in connection with the maintenance, repair, replacement, rehabilitation or reconstruction of a structure or facility, in kind, on the same site, including upgrading buildings to meet building or fire codes. As a Type II action, the Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA.
