

**RESOLUTION NO. 74 -2018, AMENDING THE 2018 ADOPTED
OPERATING BUDGET TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE EAST
END CLASSIC BOAT SOCIETY**

WHEREAS, Omnibus Resolution No. 901-2017 provided \$5,000 for the East End Classic Boat Society, but due to a typographical error in the Activity Code, the 2018 Adopted Budget did not include a budget line for this agency; and

WHEREAS, in the adopted budget, the \$5,000 intended for the East End Classic Boat Society was instead added to another agency's budget line (South Fork Natural History Museum); and

WHEREAS, the County Legislature desires to amend the 2018 Adopted Operating Budget to provide each agency with funding of \$5,000, as originally intended during the budget adoption process; now, therefore be it

1st **RESOLVED**, that the 2018 County Operating Budget is hereby amended as follows and that the County Comptroller be and hereby is authorized to transfer the following funds and authorizations:

3rd **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20), (21) and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
