

**HOME RULE MESSAGE REQUESTING THE NEW YORK STATE
LEGISLATURE TO AMEND CHAPTER 719 OF THE LAWS OF
1982 (ASSEMBLY BILL A. 06518A-2013 AND SENATE BILL S.
03816A-2013)**

WHEREAS, Chapter 719 of the Laws of 1982 restricts the use of certain state lands transferred by the Commissioner of General Services to the Town of Islip in Suffolk County to certain educational, municipal and related purposes; and

WHEREAS, Suffolk County recognizes the desirability to encourage the promotion of public safety in the area of such restricted lands; and

WHEREAS, Suffolk County finds that the erection of a substation for the Central Islip Fire Department on such state lands would be beneficial and desirable; and

WHEREAS, this legislation will exempt from such restrictions a certain parcel of such lands comprised of approximately two acres and authorize the Town of Islip to utilize and convey the exempted parcel free of the restrictions set forth in Section 7 of Chapter 719 of the Laws of 1982; now, therefore, be it

1st **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature hereby requests the State of New York to enact Assembly Bill A. 06518A-2013 and Senate Bill S. 03816A-2013 for the purpose of permitting the Town of Islip to transfer lands transferred to it by the Commissioner of General Services without the restrictions imposed by Section 7 of Chapter 719 of the laws of 1982; and be it further

2nd **RESOLVED**, that the Clerk of this Legislature is hereby directed to forward copies of this Resolution to Governor Andrew M. Cuomo; to the Majority Leader of the New York State Senate Dean G. Skelos; to the Speaker of the New York State Assembly Sheldon Silver; to the Minority Leaders of the New York State Senate and the New York State Assembly; and to each member of the Long Island delegation to the New York State Legislature.
