

**RESOLUTION NO. 332 -2017, AMENDING THE 2017 CAPITAL BUDGET AND PROGRAM AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN CONNECTION WITH TRAFFIC SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS FOR CR 21 IN PROXIMITY TO ROCKY POINT SCHOOLS (CP 3315)**

**WHEREAS**, Rocky Point Elementary School, Middle School, and High School could benefit from additional safety measures due to their proximity to CR 21; and

**WHEREAS**, this particular section of roadway has experienced a significant number of accidents where cars run off the road into the woods or on to school property; and

**WHEREAS**, a study should be conducted within the vicinity of CR 21 and the Rocky Point Schools to improve safety for both motorists and school children whom utilize the sidewalks in this area; and

**WHEREAS**, the study should explore all potential costs associated with implementing enhanced measures to ensure adequate safety is afforded to those traveling in the area; and

**WHEREAS**, that this Legislature, by resolution of even date herewith, has authorized the issuance of \$150,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 471-1994, as revised by Resolution No. 571-1998, Resolution No. 209-2000 and Resolution No. 461-2006 established the use of a priority ranking system, implemented in the Adopted 2017 Capital Budget, as the basis for funding capital projects such as this project; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup> RESOLVED**, that it is hereby determined that this project, with a priority ranking of forty-eight (48) is eligible for approval in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 471-1994 as revised by Resolution No. 571-1998, Resolution No. 209-2000 and Resolution No. 461-2006; and be it further

**2<sup>nd</sup> RESOLVED**, that the 2017 Capital Budget and Program be and is hereby amended as follows:

**5<sup>th</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA"), Environmental Conservation Law Article 8, hereby finds and determines that this law constitutes a Type II action, pursuant to Section 617.5 (C) (18), (21) and (27) of Title 6 of New York Code of Rules and Regulations ("NYCRR"), in that the law authorizes information collection, including basic data collection and research, and preliminary planning processes necessary to formulate a proposal for an action, but does not commit the County to commence or approve an action. Since this law is a Type II action, the Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA.
