I.R. 1014 – Renewal and extension of Ferry License and Fares for Tony’s Freight Services, Inc. (P.O.) Public Works & Transportation

I.R. 1100 – A Local Law to increase awareness of the harmful effects of tobacco use. (Cooper) Health & Human Services (Recessed from 3/8)

I.R. 1103 – A Local Law to amend Chapter 152 of the Administrative Local Law exempting the Health Commissioner and the Chief Medical Examiner from certain salary caps. (Co. Exec.) Labor, Housing and Consumer Protection (Recessed from 3/8)

I.R. 1225 - Extension of License and Franchise of Davis Park Ferry Co., Inc. for Cross Bay Service between Patchogue, NY and Fire Island Community of Davis Park. (P.O.) Public Works & Transportation (Procedural Motion 9-11)
