**RESOLUTION NO. 811 -2018, ACCEPTING THE DONATION
OF A TICK WARNING SIGN FROM GOOD SAMARITAN
HOSPITAL**

WHEREAS, preventing the spread of tick-borne illnesses continues to be a top public health priority in Suffolk County; and

WHEREAS, public education is a critical component in the effort to prevent tick-borne illnesses; and

WHEREAS, Good Samaritan Hospital wishes to donate a sign, which provides a warning about ticks, to the County of Suffolk for installation at Gardiner Manor Park in Bay Shore; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the County of Suffolk pursuant to Section A3-10 of the SUFFOLK COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, hereby accepts the donation of a tick warning sign as depicted in the attached Exhibit "A", from Good Samaritan Hospital, West Islip; and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that the Department of Parks, Recreation and Conservation is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to receive and install the donated sign at an appropriate location at Suffolk County Gardiner Manor Park in Bay Shore; and be it further

3rd RESOLVED, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20), (21) and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
