

PROCEDURAL MOTION NO. 6-2019, APPROVING THE CONSOLIDATION OF VITAL REGISTRATION DISTRICTS BETWEEN THE TOWN OF SMITHTOWN AND THE VILLAGES OF VILLAGE OF THE BRANCH, NISSEQUOGUE, AND HEAD OF THE HARBOR

WHEREAS, the Registrars of Vital Statistics of the Town of Smithtown, the Village of the Branch, the Village of Nissequogue and the Village of Head of the Harbor have entered into an agreement to consolidate the villages with the Town of Smithtown into one primary registration district of the Town of Smithtown; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 4120(2)(a) of the Public Health Law, such action is subject to the approval of the Suffolk County Legislature; and

WHEREAS, resolutions from each of these municipalities requesting this consolidation were approved by their respective governing bodies in January and February of 2019; and

WHEREAS, based upon approval by the Suffolk County Legislature, the New York Commissioner of Health will issue an order combining the four districts into one primary district; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that upon the request of the Town of Smithtown, the Village of the Branch, the Village of Nissequogue and the Village of Head of the Harbor, the Suffolk County Legislature hereby approves the consolidation of these four vital statistics registration district into one Town of Smithtown Primary Registration District; and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Suffolk County Legislature is hereby directed to send a certified copy of this resolution to the New York State Commissioner of Health, the Clerk of the Town of Smithtown, the Supervisor of the Town of Smithtown, the Clerks of the Villages of Village of the Branch, Nissequogue and Head of the Harbor, and the Mayors of the Villages of Village of the Branch, Nissequogue and Head of the Harbor.
