**PROCEDURAL MOTION NO. 13-2019, VESTING SUBPOENA  
AUTHORITY WITH JOEL R. WEISS, ESQ., IN RELATION TO  
AN INVESTIGATION**

**WHEREAS**, Procedural Motion No. 12-2019 authorized the Presiding Officer to retain Special Counsel in connection with the investigation of a whistleblower complaint made to him pursuant to Chapter 71 of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CODE; and

**WHEREAS**, the Presiding Officer retained Joel R. Weiss, Esq., to conduct the investigation; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Weiss has commenced his investigation and provided a confidential report to the Legislature, outlining his need for and proposed scope of subpoena authority to conduct a full, fair, and impartial investigation; now, therefore be it

**1st RESOLVED**, that the Legislature hereby vests in Joel R. Weiss, Esq., the authority to issue subpoenas to obtain documents, records and sworn testimony in relation to the investigation of a County employee claim for protection pursuant to Chapter 71 of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CODE filed with the Presiding Officer on March 19, 2019; and be it further

**2nd RESOLVED**, that the scope of the subpoena authority shall be limited to the boundaries outlined by Mr. Weiss in his confidential report filed with the Presiding Officer.
