

RESOLUTION NO. 1248-2019, APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN CONNECTION WITH THE REPLACEMENT OF SUFFOLK COUNTY HAZARDOUS MATERIAL DETECTION EQUIPMENT (CP 3423)

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Fire, Rescue and Emergency Services has requested equipment funds for the replacement of the hazardous material detection equipment utilized within the Suffolk County Regional Hazardous Material Typecasting program, which has exceeded its services life and is no longer supported or serviceable; and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds within the 2019 Capital Budget and Program to cover the cost of said request under CP 3423; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 471-1994, as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006, has established a priority ranking system of capital projects as the basis for funding capital projects such as this project; and

WHEREAS, the County Legislature, by resolution of even date herewith, has authorized the issuance of \$500,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that this Legislature, being the lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA"), Environmental Conservation Law Article 8, hereby finds and determines that this law constitutes a Type II action, pursuant to Section 617.5 (C) of Title 6 of New York Code of Rules and Regulations ("NYCRR"), in that the law authorizes (31) purchase or sale of furnishings, equipment or supplies, including surplus government property, other than the following: land, radioactive material, pesticides, herbicides, or other hazardous materials; (33) adoption of regulations, policies, procedures and local legislative decisions in connection with any action on this list, since this law is a Type II action, the Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA; and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that it is determined that this program with a priority ranking of fifty-one (51) is eligible for approval in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 471-1994, as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006; and be it further

3rd RESOLVED, that the proceeds of \$500,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds be and they are hereby appropriated as follows:
