**RESOLUTION NO. 1252-2019, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 1038-2018 FOR THE INNOVATIONS IN COMMUNITY BASED CRIME REDUCTION 2018 GRANT PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 1038-2018 accepted and appropriated \$999,678 in Federal funding from the United States Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance for the Innovations in Community Based Crime Reduction 2018 Program with 99.17% support; and

**WHEREAS**, this resolution when adopted contained certain budgetary errors which now must be corrected to allow for accurate grant expenditure and accounting; now, therefore be it

Environmental Conservation Law Article 8 and Chapter 450 of the Suffolk County Code, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20) and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS ("NYCRR") in that the action constitutes routine or continuing agency administration and management, not including new programs or major reordering of priorities that may affect the environment. The Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
