

**RESOLUTION NO. 1296 -2019, AMENDING THE 2019 CAPITAL BUDGET AND PROGRAM AND APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL FUNDS IN CONNECTION WITH RESTORATION OF CANAAN LAKE (CP 8715)**

**WHEREAS**, the removal of invasive species in Canaan Lake will contribute to its health and restoration and provide an enhanced public experience of the site; and

**WHEREAS**, additional site improvement funds are needed at this time; and

**WHEREAS**, funding for this purpose has not been included in the 2019 Adopted Capital Budget and, pursuant to Suffolk County Charter, Section C-4-13, an offsetting authorization must be provided from another capital project; and

**WHEREAS**, this Legislature, by resolution of even date herewith, has authorized the issuance of \$1,650,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 471-1994, as revised by Resolution No. 571-1998, Resolution No. 209-2000 and Resolution No. 461-2006, established the use of a priority ranking system, implemented in the Adopted 2019 Capital Budget, as the basis for funding capital projects such as this project; and

**WHEREAS**, that this Legislature determined that the Restoration of Canaan Lake constitutes a Type I Action (as adopted by Resolution No. 990-2016), pursuant to the provisions of Title 6 NYCRR, Part 617 and Chapter 450 of the Suffolk County Code, and the proposed project will not have significant adverse impacts on the environment; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup> RESOLVED**, that it is hereby determined that this project, with a priority ranking of thirty-seven (37) is eligible for approval in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 471-1994, as revised by Resolution No. 571-1998, Resolution No. 209-2000 and Resolution No. 461-2006; and be it further

**4<sup>th</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that the County Comptroller is hereby authorized and empowered to take all steps necessary and appropriate to effectuate the transfer of this funding forthwith; and be it further

**5<sup>th</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature determined that the Proposed Invasive Species Eradication Project at Canaan Lake, Town of Brookhaven, (as adopted by Resolution No. 990-2016), constitutes a Type I Action, pursuant to the provisions of Title 6 NYCRR, Part 617 and Chapter 450 of the Suffolk County Code, and will not have significant adverse impacts on the environment for the following reasons:

1. the proposed action will not exceed any of the criteria set forth in Title 6 NYCRR, Part 617.7, which sets forth thresholds for determining significant effect on the environment as demonstrated in the Environmental Assessment Form;
2. the proposal does not appear to significantly threaten any unique or highly valuable environmental or cultural resources as identified in or regulated by the Environmental Conservation Law of the State of New York or the Suffolk County Charter or the Suffolk County Code;
3. any and all required NYSDEC freshwater wetlands permits will be obtained as well as any and all required NYSDEC and/or Suffolk County Parks Department wetland mitigation/restoration plans and wildlife management plans;
4. the proposed project is being conducted in a phased approach which will allow for the evaluation of existing conditions and completed work to inform excavation procedures as well as possible future drawdown/excavation events;
5. all excavated materials will be sampled and disposed of in accordance with NYSDEC requirements;
6. the drawdown and refilling of Canaan Lake will be done at a slow and controlled rate and include downstream monitoring to avoid downstream flooding and to minimize turbidity increases; and
7. the proposed project is anticipated to result in a long-term positive impact on the water quality in Canaan Lake by reducing the amount of invasive species and organic soft sediment which has built up in the lake.
