

RESOLUTION NO. 119 -2020, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 1225-2019, TO MODIFY THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE SUFFOLK COUNTY REGIONAL RECYCLING ASSESSMENT TASK FORCE

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 1225-2019 established a Suffolk County Regional Recycling Task Force (“Task Force”) to develop a strategy for increasing the efficiency of regional recycling efforts; and

WHEREAS, additional members should also be added to the Task Force to develop a more comprehensive assessment of regional recycling plans; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 1225-2019 should be updated to include those additional members, who will provide valuable insight into regional recycling reform; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the 2nd RESOLVED Clause of Resolution No. 1225-2019 is hereby amended to read as follows:

2nd RESOLVED, that the Task Force shall consist of the following [~~seventeen (17)~~] twenty-two (22) members:

- 1) The Chair of the Environment, ~~[Planning]~~ Parks and Agriculture Committee of the County Legislature, or his or her designee, who shall serve as Chair;
- 2) The Presiding Officer of the County Legislature, or his or her designee;
- 3) The County Executive, or his or her designee;
- 4) The Commissioner of the Department of Economic Development and Planning, or his or her designee;
- 5) The Commissioner of the Department of Public Works, or his or her designee;
- 6) The recycling coordinators from each of the ten (10) towns; ~~[and]~~
- 7) Two (2) community advocates, to be appointed by the Legislature;
- 8) One (1) representative from the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation;
- 9) One (1) representative from the Long Island Regional Planning Council;
and
- 10) Three (3) representatives who have experience working in the recycling industry; and be it further

and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that the 6th RESOLVED Clause of Resolution No. 1225-2019 is hereby amended to read as follows:

6th RESOLVED, that [~~nine (9)~~] twelve (12) members of the Task Force shall constitute a quorum to transact the business of the Task Force at both regular and special meetings; and be it further

3rd RESOLVED, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(26) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as routine or continuing administration and management not including new programs or major reordering of priorities that may affect the environment, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
