RESOLUTION NO. 145 -2020, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 1246-2019 IN CONNECTION WITH SUFFOLK COUNTY AUXILIARY POLICE PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (CP 3424)

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Fire, Rescue and Emergency Services had requested equipment funds for the replacement of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) for current and new Auxiliary Police Officers; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 1246-2019 authorized the issuance of \$100,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds to cover the cost of said request under Capital Project No. 3424 within the 2019 Capital Budget; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 1246-2019 should be amended for correction of SEQRA and additional typographical errors; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the 1st Resolved clause of Resolution No. 1246-2019 is hereby amended as follows:

1st RESOLVED, that this Legislature, being the lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA"), Environmental Conservation Law Article 8, hereby finds and determines that this law constitutes a Type II action, pursuant to Section 617.5 (C) of Title 6 of New York Code of Rules and Regulations ("NYCRR"), in that the law authorizes (31) purchase or sale of furnishings, equipment or supplies, including surplus government property, other than the following: land, radioactive material, pesticides, herbicides, or other hazardous materials; (33) adoption of regulations, policies, procedures and local legislative decisions in connection with any action on this list, since this law is a Type II action, the Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA; and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that the 3rd Resolved clause of Resolution No. 1246-2019 is hereby amended as follows:
