RESOLUTION NO. 388 -2020, REPLACEMENT OF LIFESAVING CARDIAC EQUIPMENT FOR POLICE DEPARTMENT (CP 3205)

WHEREAS, the Police Commissioner has requested funds to purchase lifesaving cardiac equipment for the Police Department’s emergency medical care program; and

WHEREAS, the three aspects of the department’s medical care program are automated external defibrillators, cardiac monitor/defibrillators and automated cardiac compression devices; and

WHEREAS, officers respond to approximately 98,000 aided cases and 8,000 personal injury motor vehicle accidents annually; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of new and improved cardiac equipment will allow officers to continue to deliver critical emergency cardiac treatment to the residents of Suffolk County; and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds within the 2020 Capital Budget and Program to cover the cost of said purchase under CP 3205; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 471-1994, as amended by Resolution No. 461-2006, has established a priority ranking system, implemented in the 2020 Adopted Capital Budget and Program, as the basis for funding capital projects such as this project; and

WHEREAS, the County Legislature, by resolution of even date herewith, has authorized the issuance of \$275,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) Lead Agency, hereby finds and determines that the adoption of this resolution constitutes a Type II Action pursuant to Title 6 NYCRR Part 617.5 (C) as this legislative decision involves the routine or continuing agency administration and management involving (31)purchase of furnishings, equipment or supplies other than the following: land, radioactive material, pesticides, herbicides or other hazardous materials; (33) adoption of regulations, policies, procedures and local legislative decisions in connection with any action on this list As such, this Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA; and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that it is determined that this program with a priority ranking of forty-seven (47) is eligible for approval in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 471-1994, as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006; and be it further

3rd RESOLVED, that the proceeds of \$275,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds be and they are hereby appropriated as follows:
