**RESOLUTION NO.       -2020, ACCEPTING AND APPROVING  
THE LANGUAGE AND DESIGN OF THE ASTHMA INHALER  
EDUCATIONAL SIGN REQUIRED PURSUANT TO  
RESOLUTION NO. XXX-2020**

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. xxx-2020 requires that stores containing a pharmacy in Suffolk County must post a sign explaining the differences between different types of asthma inhalers; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. xxx-2020 also establishes a requirement that the Department of Health Services submit the language and design of said sign to the County Legislature for approval via resolution within six (6) months of the effective date of the law; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Health Services recently completed the language and design of the sign, attached to this Resolution as Exhibit "A", and would like to move forward with the implementation of this law; now, therefore be it

**1st           RESOLVED**, that this Legislature hereby approves of the prototype sign, developed by the Department of Health Services in conformance with Resolution No. xxx-2020 and attached hereto as Exhibit "A", for use in stores that contain a pharmacy in Suffolk County; and be it further

**2nd           RESOLVED**, that, to implement the requirements set forth in Resolution No. xxx-2020, the Department of Health Services is hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to post the sign on the webpage established pursuant to Section 4(C) of Resolution No. xxx-2020 and provide copies of the signs in PDF form upon written request to the stores that contain a pharmacy in Suffolk County; and be it further

**3rd           RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(26) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as routine or continuing administration and management not including new programs or major reordering of priorities that may affect the environment, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
