

**RESOLUTION NO. 583 -2020, AMENDING RESOLUTION
NO. 439-2020 TO INCLUDE ADDITIONAL MEMBERS IN THE
WORKING GROUP**

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 439-2020 created an internal working group to develop new policies and procedures to enhance communication between law enforcement and the department of social services; and

WHEREAS, there are additional entities which may be able to provide important insights on these issues and should be included as members of the working group; and

WHEREAS, the deadline should also be extended to allow for additional time for the group to conduct their work; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 439-2020 should be amended to add new members to the working group and provide 60 additional days for the issuance of their written report; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, the 2nd RESOLVED clause of Resolution No. 439-2020 is hereby amended as follows:

2nd RESOLVED, that the following [nine (9)] thirteen (13) members shall serve on the working group:

- 1) A legislator selected by the Presiding Officer, who shall serve as chair;
- 2) A legislator selected by the Minority Leader;
- 3) The Commissioner of the Department of Social Services;
- 4) The Commissioner of the Suffolk County Police Department;
- 5) The direct manager of the Child Protective Services Bureau in the Department of Social Services;
- 6) A representative of the Suffolk County Police Benevolent Association;
- 7) A representative of the Suffolk County Superior Officers Association;
- 8) A representative of Suffolk County Association of Municipal Employees;
- [and]
- 9) The County Executive, or his designee;
- 10) A representative from the Suffolk County District Attorney's Office;
- 11) A representative from the Suffolk County Detective's Association;
- 12) A representative from the New York State Troopers, Inc.; and
- 13) A representative from the Suffolk County East End Chief's Association;

and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, the 6th RESOLVED clause of Resolution No. 439-2020 is hereby amended as follows:

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6th RESOLVED, that a written report of the recommendations of the working group shall be provided to the County Executive, Clerk of the Legislature and each member of the County Legislature within ~~[120]~~ 180 days of the effective date of this resolution;

3rd RESOLVED, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(26) and (33) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW insofar as these actions constitute routine or continuing administration and management not including new programs or major reordering of priorities that may affect the environment, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
