**RESOLUTION NO. -2020, APPOINT A MEMBER TO THE
SUFFOLK COUNTY WOMEN VETERANS ADVISORY BOARD
(JENNIFER L. BAKER)**

WHEREAS, Local Law No. 27-2019 created the Suffolk County Women Veterans Advisory Board to discuss issues of importance and relevance to the women veterans community and to make recommendations regarding proposed legislation, policies and programming; and

WHEREAS, the membership of the Suffolk County Women Veterans Advisory Board shall include one female veteran from each of the five service branches of the United States military; and

WHEREAS, Denise M. Williams resigned as a member of the Suffolk County Women Veterans Advisory Board representing the United States Army on June 16, 2020; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that Jennifer L. Baker, currently residing in St. James, New York, is hereby appointed as a member of the Women Veterans Advisory Board, as the female veteran representing the United States Army, for a term of office that shall expire on December 17, 2022, pursuant to Chapter 261-3(A) of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CODE.
