**RESOLUTION NO.                   -2021, AMENDING THE 2020  
OPERATING BUDGET TO PLACE CERTAIN FUNDING INTO A  
DEDICATED RESERVE FUND FOR CULTURAL  
PROGRAMMING ORGANIZATIONS**

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 549-2020 established a limited reserve fund for organizations which receive funding from the County's tax on hotel and motel occupancy to provide cultural arts programming; and

**WHEREAS**, under the terms of Resolution No. 549-2020, organizations slated to receive cultural arts funds in 2020 may request that all or part of their funding be set aside for use in 2021 due to the COVID-19 pandemic; and

**WHEREAS**, a number of organizations have stated that they will be unable to provide cultural arts programming this year and requested that their funding be put into the limited reserve fund; and

**WHEREAS**, the 2020 Operating Budget should be amended to ensure the following organizations have the portion of their 2020 allocation transferred into the reserve fund established pursuant to Resolution No. 549-2020; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 4-31 (G) of the Suffolk County Charter now allows amendment of the County Operating Budget by County Legislators four times during the fiscal year as long as the amendment reduces, lowers, terminates or cancels appropriations; abolishes positions of employment; terminates contract agencies; terminates or reduces the size of County programs or departments, or makes transfers of appropriations that are offset by reductions in other programs; now, therefore be it

**1st                   RESOLVED**, that Resolution No. 549-2020 established the 2020 Hotel Motel Arts and Cultural Programming Reserve Fund; and be it further

**2nd                   RESOLVED**, that the 2020 County Operating Budget is hereby amended as follows and that the County Comptroller be and hereby is authorized to transfer the following funds and authorizations from Fund 192 to Fund 193 as indicated in the Amount column in the following table:

**3rd RESOLVED**, that the authorized amounts may be prorated, with each organization being reduced at the same percentage rate, dependent upon the estimated final total lodging tax collections for fiscal year 2020, as reported by the comptroller's office on or before December 20<sup>th</sup>, 2020, and

**4th RESOLVED**, that the funds allocated in this Resolution shall in no instance be derived from any funding received in 2021 from the County hotel and motel occupancy tax; and be it further

**5th RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(26) and (33) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW insofar as these actions constitute routine or continuing administration and management not including new programs or major reordering of priorities that may affect the environment, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
