33 **Voicemail Testimony Submission**

34  
35  
36 Hi. My name is JOE COLAO, C-0-L-A-0. I am very much in support to  
37 amend the County Human Rights Law to include false reporting of  
38 crimes based on bias.

39  
40 With regards to the purchasing of open space property in Riverhead,  
41 the two parcels, while I don't know where they are, I think besides  
42 of all the environmental reasons and park reasons why the  
43 recreation area or the preserved land should be purchased. In  
44 addition, I feel, from an economic perspective, that they should be  
45 purchased, because Riverhead has -- its overdevelopment has caused  
46 taxes to go up crazy.

47  
48 And by purchasing that property and taking it off the tax roll,  
49 clearly, the deer, the chipmunk and the raccoons that live up there  
50 won't cost us any money. So, from the taxpayers' perspective, buy  
51 it, take it off the tax rolls, and that would be absolutely fine  
52 economically for people of Riverhead who need tax relief. Buy the  
53 property, take it off the tax rolls, and it will be cheaper for us  
54 than building houses or any other structures that would require tax  
55 abatements, tax breaks in the name of development lowers taxes.  
56 That doesn't happen. Thank you very much.
