RESOLUTION NO. 828-2020, AMENDING THE 2021 OPERATING BUDGET TO INCLUDE A SUMMARY OF THE FINAL LEGISLATIVE ACTIONS TAKEN ON THE 2021 RECOMMENDED OPERATING BUDGET AS A COMPONENT OF THE ADOPTED OPERATING BUDGET

WHEREAS, the County Executive submitted the 2021 Recommended Operating Budget; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature introduced multiple budget amendments for consideration and possible action to amend the 2021 Recommended Operating Budget; and

WHEREAS, the Government Finance Officers Association's (GFOA) best practice recommends including a summary of significant changes between recommended and adopted operating budget to provide transparency; and

WHEREAS, a record should be produced by the Legislative Office of Budget Review to summarize the final adopted actions taken by the Legislature on the 2021 Operating Budget and said summary should be included as part of the 2021 Adopted Operating Budget; now therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the Legislative Office of Budget Review is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to prepare a summary of the final legislative actions taken with respect to the adoption of the 2021 Operating Budget; and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that the summary of final legislative actions shall itemize all adopted budget amending resolutions; and be it further

3rd RESOLVED, that the Legislative Office of Budget Review shall provide the summary of the adopted legislative actions to the County Executive's Budget Office within three (3) business days after the final disposition of the 2021 Adopted Operating Budget; and be it further

4th RESOLVED, that the County Executive is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to affix and incorporate the summary of the adopted legislative actions authorized by this Resolution into the final budget document; and be it further

5th RESOLVED, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(26) and (33) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW insofar as these actions constitute routine or continuing administration and management not including new programs or major reordering of priorities that may affect the environment, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
