

**HOME RULE MESSAGE REQUESTING THE STATE OF
NEW YORK TO ADOPT AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE
ALIENATION AND DISCONTINUATION OF USE OF
CERTAIN PARKLANDS IN THE COUNTY OF SUFFOLK
(A.8011/S.7182)**

WHEREAS, the County of Suffolk owns approximately 8.9 acres of property, more commonly known as part of the BOMARC site, which is currently designated as parkland; and

WHEREAS, Assembly bill A.8011 and Senate bill S.7182 authorize the County to seek alienation of this parkland from the State Legislature so that it can be utilized for public works purposes; and

WHEREAS, in exchange for alienating these parcels, roughly 21.5 acres of land in the Town of Southampton, which is also part of the BOMARC site owned by the County, would be dedicated as parkland; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that this Legislature hereby supports Assembly bill A.8011 and Senate bill S.7182; and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that the Clerk of this Legislature is hereby directed to forward copies of this Resolution to Governor Andrew M. Cuomo; to the Majority Leader of the New York State Senate Andrea Stewart-Cousins; to the Speaker of the New York State Assembly Carl E. Heastie; to the Minority Leaders of the New York State Senate and the New York State Assembly; and to each member of the Long Island delegation to the New York State Legislature.
