**HOME RULE MESSAGE REQUESTING THE STATE OF
NEW YORK TO ENACT LEGISLATION RELATING TO
THE ENFORCEMENT OF INTERESTS IN REAL
PROPERTY PRESERVED AS OPEN SPACE IN THE
VILLAGE OF SAGAPONACK (S.4024/A.4216)**

WHEREAS, Senate Bill S.4024 and Assembly Bill A.4216 seek to provide the Village of Sagaponack with the ability to enforce any interest acquired by a municipal corporation within the Village pursuant to Section 247 of the General Municipal Law for open space preservation purposes; and

WHEREAS, the County of Suffolk may acquire parcels for open space preservation purposes within the Village of Sagaponack and, as a result, requests that the Village be empowered to enforce those interests through their governing board; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Sagaponack has already submitted a Home Rule Message relating to these resolutions; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that this Legislature hereby supports Senate Bill S.4024 and Assembly Bill A.4216; and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that the Clerk of this Legislature is hereby directed to forward copies of this Resolution to Governor Andrew M. Cuomo; to the Majority Leader of the New York State Senate Andrea Stewart-Cousins; to the Speaker of the New York State Assembly Carl E. Heastie; to the Minority Leaders of the New York State Senate and the New York State Assembly; and to each member of the Long Island delegation to the New York State Legislature.
