RESOLUTION NO. 435-2021, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE SMITH POINT LIFEGUARD ASSOCIATION, NYSUT ADOPTING THE 2021 SALARY SCALE

WHEREAS, the County and the President of the Smith Point Lifeguard Association, NYSUT have reached an Agreement for the 2021 salary scale for its members effective at the beginning of the 2021 season, subject to the approval, to the extent necessary, by the Suffolk County Legislature; and

WHEREAS, such Agreement has been set down in a Stipulation of Agreement, a copy of which has been filed with the Clerk of the Suffolk County Legislature; and

WHEREAS, such Agreement is subject to ratification by a majority of the members of the Smith Point Lifeguard Association NYSUT; now, therefore be it

1st **RESOLVED**, that the County Executive, or his designee, be and is hereby authorized to execute an Agreement with the Smith Point Lifeguard Association NYSUT in accordance with the Stipulation of Agreement dated June 4, 2021, a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Suffolk County Legislature, adopting the 2021 salary scale for the members of the Smith Point Lifeguard Association effective at the beginning of and through the 2021 season; and be it further

2nd **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(26), (27) and (33) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) AND WITHIN THE MEANING OF Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management, and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
