**RESOLUTION NO. 708-2021, EXTENDING THE COASTAL  
RESILIENCY AND SEA LEVEL RISE TASK FORCE**

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 71-2020 established the Coastal Resiliency and Sea Level Rise Task Force to develop coastal resiliency policies and recommendations to assist Suffolk County and the municipalities located therein in protecting coastlines from erosion and other environmental damages due to sea level rise; and

**WHEREAS**, as a result of the coronavirus pandemic, the Task Force needs additional time to obtain the information needed to complete its findings and determinations than was originally anticipated; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 71-2020 should be amended to extend the date that the Task Force shall expire; now, therefore be it

**1st RESOLVED**, that the 11th RESOLVED clause of Resolution No. 71-2020 is hereby amended as follows:

**11th RESOLVED**, that the Task Force shall expire, and the terms of office of its members terminate, as of [~~March 1, 2021~~] September 1, 2022 at which time the Task Force shall deposit all the records of its proceedings with the Clerk of the Legislature; and be it further

**2nd RESOLVED**, that all other terms and conditions of Resolution No. 71-2020 shall remain in full force and effect; and be it further

**3rd RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(26) and (33) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW insofar as these actions constitute routine or continuing administration and management not including new programs or major reordering of priorities that may affect the environment, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
