

Due to public health and safety concerns related to COVID-19 the County Legislature's Public Hearings will be held both in person and via Zoom on July 27 at 2:00 pm. In accordance with county and state COVID-19 safety protocols, members of the public who wish to provide in-person testimony may do so after having a temperature check upon entry into our building. Visitors who are vaccinated against COVID-19 and who are willing to provide proof of vaccination, if requested, will not be required to wear a mask while inside our building. Those who are not vaccinated or who do not wish to disclose their vaccination status will be required to wear a mask at all times while inside the building. Inside the Rose Caracappa Auditorium, there will be designated seating areas for vaccinated and unvaccinated individuals.
