**RESOLUTION NO. 805-2021, APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT FOR GROUNDWATER MONITORING AND WELL DRILLING AND APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF A REPLACEMENT VEHICLE IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION (B)(6) OF THE SUFFOLK COUNTY CODE AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE COUNTY VEHICLE STANDARD LAW (CP 8226)**

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioner of Health Services has requested funds for the purchase of Equipment for Groundwater Monitoring and Well Drilling; and

**WHEREAS**, the equipment will be used to drill wells and conduct groundwater research to protect Suffolk County's sole-source aquifer; and

**WHEREAS**, the equipment request includes funds to replace a 2006 Ford F-250 pick-up truck (Fleet #29041) used for groundwater field work; and

**WHEREAS**, and Local Law No. 20-2003 requires that no vehicle shall be purchased or leased unless "explicit approval for the acquisition of such vehicles, via lease or purchase, has been granted via duly enacted Resolution of the Suffolk County Legislature"; and

**WHEREAS**, there are sufficient funds within the 2021 Adopted Capital Budget and Program to cover the cost of said request under Capital Program Number 8226; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 1027-2020, established the use of a new priority capital ranking system, effective January 1, 2021, as the basis for funding capital projects such as this project, and as required, an updated capital project ranking form was completed for this project; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Legislature has authorized the issuance of \$150,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds pending adoption of bond resolution; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup> RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) Lead Agency, hereby finds and determines that the adoption of this resolution constitutes a Type II Action pursuant to Title 6 NYCRR Part 617.5(c)(26) as this action involves routine or continuing agency administration and management; (31) purchase of furnishings, equipment or supplies other than the following: land, radioactive material, pesticides, herbicides or other hazardous materials; (33) adoption of regulations, policies, procedures and local legislative decisions in connection with any action on this list. As such, this Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA; and be it further

**2<sup>nd</sup> RESOLVED**, that it is hereby determined that this project, with a priority ranking of sixty (60) is eligible for approval in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 1027-2020; and be it further

**3<sup>rd</sup> RESOLVED**, that the Department of Health Services is hereby authorized to replace a 2006 Ford F-250 pick-up truck (Fleet #29041); and be it further

4<sup>th</sup> **RESOLVED**, that the proceeds of \$150,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds be and they are hereby appropriated as follows:
