RESOLUTION NO. 1182-2021, AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AN INTERMUNICIPAL AGREEMENT WITH THE TOWN OF BROOKHAVEN FOR THE TRANSFER AND DEVELOPMENT OF THE BLUE POINT LAUNDRY SITE (CP 8244)

WHEREAS, the former Blue Point Laundry site ("Site") was remediated in 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Law has approved an Intermunicipal agreement ("IMA") with the Town of Brookhaven for the development of the Site and the IMA is attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; now, therefore be it

1st **RESOLVED**, that the County Executive, or his designee, be and hereby is authorized and directed, subject to County Attorney approval, to execute the proposed IMA attached hereto as Exhibit "A" in a form substantially similar thereto and to execute such other documents as may be necessary and appropriate, consistent with the purposes and intent of the foregoing resolution, to effectuate the terms of the IMA; and be it further

2nd **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA"), N.Y. Environmental Conservation Law Article 8, hereby finds and determines that this law constitutes a Type II action, pursuant to Section 617.5 (C)(26) and (33) of Title 6 of New York Code of Rules and Regulations (NYCRR), in that the resolution concerns routine or continuing agency administration and management, not including new programs or major reordering of priorities that may affect the environment, and adoption of a local legislative decision in connection with the same; and the Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA.
