**RESOLUTION NO. 861-2021, AUTHORIZING ILLUMINATION  
OF THE H. LEE DENNISON EXECUTIVE OFFICE BUILDING IN  
RECOGNITION OF VETERANS DAY**

**WHEREAS**, November 11<sup>th</sup> marks the federal holiday of Veterans Day in the United States; and

**WHEREAS**, the holiday honors our nation's military veterans, who are individuals who have served in the United States Armed Forces; and

**WHEREAS**, military veterans serve our communities in a variety of ways, chief among them being protecting the values and liberties that our nation was built on; and

**WHEREAS**, Suffolk County is home to the largest number of veterans in the New York State; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that beginning in 2021 and continuing every year thereafter, that the Department of Public Work is hereby authorized, empowered and directed, pursuant to Section C8-2(W) of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CHARTER to illuminate the north side of the H. Lee Dennison Executive Office Building facing Veterans Memorial Highway with an green hue on November 11<sup>th</sup>; and be it further

**2<sup>nd</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(26) and (33) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW insofar as these actions constitute routine or continuing administration and management not including new programs or major reordering of priorities that may affect the environment, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
