RESOLUTION NO. 1138-2021, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 596-2018, EXTENDING AUTHORIZATION FOR THE CARMANS RIVER FISH PASSAGE AT LOWER YAPHANK LAKE PROJECT (CP 7180)

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 596-2018 was adopted by the Suffolk County Legislature on July 17, 2018; and

WHEREAS, due to the historical/archeological sensitivity of the project compounded by implications of COVID-19 the timeline for project construction was delayed; now, therefore be it

1st **RESOLVED** that the twelfth WHEREAS clause of Resolution No. 596-2018 is hereby amended as follows:

WHEREAS, the project will be completed [within three years of the date of adoption of this Resolution] by December 31, 2022; and

2nd **RESOLVED** that the funding currently residing in CP 7180 be retained for the purpose of the Carmans River Fish Passage at Lower Yaphank Lake Project;

and be it further

3rd **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA), Environmental Conservation Law Article 8, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action, pursuant to Section 617.5 (c) (26) of Title 6 of the NYCRR as routine or continuing agency administration and management, not including new programs or major reordering of priorities that may affect the environment, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
