Due to limited supplies and to ensure wide access, we are limiting distribution as follows:

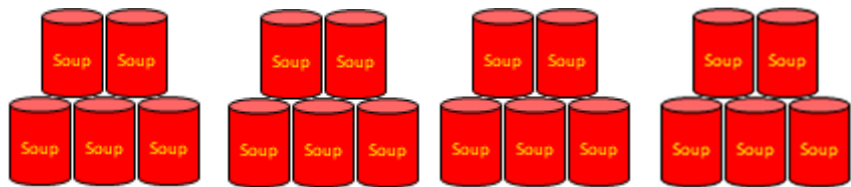
Masks: 1 box of 10 per household
