

RESOLUTION NO. 505-2023, DIRECTING THE LEGISLATURE'S TECHNOLOGY UNIT ("LTU") TO DEVELOP AND INSTITUTE A WEB PAGE FOR THE ILLUMINATION OF THE H. LEE DENNISON EXECUTIVE OFFICE BUILDING

WHEREAS, over the years, the County of Suffolk has authorized the illumination of the H. Lee Dennison Executive Office Building ("Dennison Building") for a host of important causes and initiatives; and

WHEREAS, as citizens and visitors to the County drive along Veterans Memorial Highway, the iconic Dennison Building is often illuminated in different colors to signify these various causes and events; and

WHEREAS, passersby are often curious as to why the Dennison Building is displaying different colors throughout the year; and

WHEREAS, the County wishes to provide citizens and visitors a site where they can find out the significance of why the Dennison Building is illuminated on any given evening; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the Legislature's Technology Unit ("LTU") is hereby authorized and directed to develop a webpage specifically tailored to the illumination of the H. Lee Dennison Executive Office Building ("Dennison Building"); and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that the Dennison Building webpage shall provide information including, but not limited to, the date of the lighting, the color the building will be illuminated, the significance of the illumination, a link to the resolution that directed the illumination, as well as a link for the public to view a full calendar of all the illuminations at the Dennison Building; and be it further

3rd RESOLVED, that the Suffolk County Department of Public Works is hereby directed to provide the information of all the dates of the illuminations and update the Legislature's Department of Information Technology (LTU") on a quarterly basis on January 15th, April 15th, July 15th and October 15th of each year of each year of all subsequent illumination dates; and be it further

4th RESOLVED, that the Dennison Building webpage shall be fully designed and operational within 120 days of the effective date of this resolution; and be it further

5th RESOLVED, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(26) and (33) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW insofar as these actions constitute routine or continuing administration and management not including new programs or major reordering of priorities that may affect the environment, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
